RESULTS OF THE SURVEY OF THE FINAL YEAR STUDENTS OF THE FACULTY OF TECHNOLOGIES



2021-2022

The aim of the survey: to reveal the fulfilment of student expectations during the whole study period and students' opinion about the preparation for the labour market.

The survey was conducted online in **January** and **June**, **2022**, using the LimeSurvey survey system. The obtained data was processed using SPSS 20 for Windows software.

The questionnaire was sent to 250 final year students of the Faculty of Technology, the total number of 71 was returned (28.4 %). Research error is 9.9 percent.

SURVEY RESULTS (N=71)

The total number of 71 final year students of the Faculty of Technologies participated in the survey: 57 (80.3 %) full-time students and 14 (19.7 %) part-time students. 87.3 % of the respondents hold state-funded study places. Nearly half (46.4 %) of the respondents have jobs.

Students rated the possibility to use special equipment, laboratories, and other facilities to perform individual assignments with the highest scores: the average of the evaluations was 4.1. When assessing the adequacy of support and services at the institution, students rated academic support the best. Students would need more information about psychological support, employment opportunities and the services provided by the Career Centre.

More than a half of students (58.1%) are satisfied or completely satisfied with their studies. 71.9 percent of students feel ready for a professional career. 14.1 percent of respondents intend to continue their studies at universities. More than half (54.9 %) of the respondents chose the values of 7 to 10 when rating the study program recommendation.

It can be assumed that more attention should be paid to updating the content of studies, ensuring the quality of practices, improving communication between students preparing final theses and their supervising teachers, ensuring timely dissemination of information.
