THE FACULTY OF ARTS AND EDUCATION RESULTS OF STUDENT'S SURVEY ON THE QUALITY OF THE SUBJECT/MODULE AND ITS TEACHING Autumn semester of 2023/2024



Period

Courses/modules taken in the autumn semester of 2023-2024 could be assessed by obtaining a final grade for the course/module by 29 February 2024.

Aim

To reveal students' perceptions of the quality of the content and delivery of the course/module.


Method

Questionnaire survey (quantitative and qualitative empirical data collection). The survey was carried out in the Study Management System. Participation in the survey was voluntary, confidential and anonymous.

Results

Students evaluated the quality of the course/module and its components in terms of content and teaching on a five-point scale, with 1 being strongly disagree and 5 being strongly agree.

The Faculty of Arts and Education has the highest rating for the quality of content and teaching of study subjects (91.15% and 91.03% respectively). More attention should be paid to the development of feedback in Fashion Design, Design.

Figure 1: Assessment of the quality of the subject/module content in the Faculty of Arts and Education (N=1047)




Figure 2: Evaluation of the quality of teaching of a subject/module at the Faculty of Arts and Education (N=1036)
